SHOPS & SERVICES

INSTITUTIONS

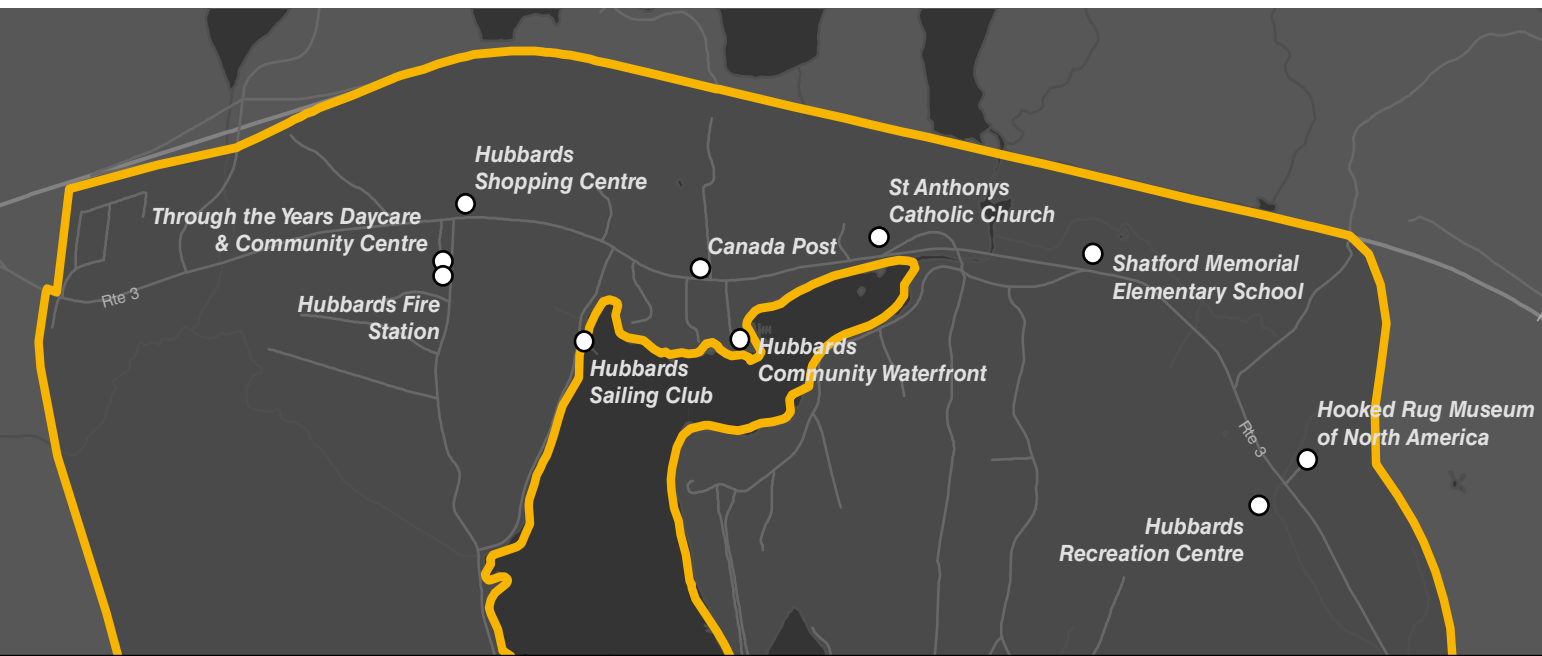

COMMUNITY FEATURES & PLANNING

Community features are an important consideration when creating a Community Plan. They are a major part of the fabric that make up a community. Many of these features are destinations that residents visit on any given day, like the grocery store, the pharmacy or the school. Community features are also destinations that tourists will be drawn to when visiting the community.



Mapping community features helps to determine important routes, especially when thinking about transportation from a pedestrian or cyclist perspective. It also shows activity nodes within the community and where future growth could be directed to strengthen the sense of place in Hubbards.
